GUIDELINES FOR SUMMER UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Applications for Summer Undergraduate Research Scholarships are available for students who have completed at least the equivalent of three years full-time study towards their first degree in an Australian University. International students currently studying at an Australian University are eligible, students must have a valid visa and Overseas Student Health Cover.

2. Up to 10 Scholarships will be available each summer and can be undertaken in any of the four Schools:

[School of Humanities and Social Sciences](#) (HASS)

[School of Physical, Environmental and Mathematical Sciences](#) (PEMS)

Relevant fields of research are available on the School webpage.

3. This program provides an opportunity for students to interact with active researchers to gain research skills, learn how to present research results and test their abilities in a particular area of research. This interaction is aimed at informing the students' decisions regarding further higher degree studies.

4. The duration of the scholarship is a minimum of six weeks and a maximum of 10 weeks. The exact duration is determined following consultation with supervisor/School. The Summer Undergraduate Research Scholarship is available from December to February the following year.

5. Successful applicants will be provided with a weekly allowance at a rate of \$500 (tax exempt) per week, up to a total amount of \$5000 for the duration of a 10 week scholarship. Applicants whose homes are not in the Canberra area will be required to make appropriate accommodation arrangements.
